

On February 16 we held our regular bi-annual Voters Assembly with the primary purpose to elect members for the Mission & Ministry Council. Following that election, we're pleased to congratulate Dale Rudy (Vice Chairperson taking over for Bob Schmidt), Josh Ladwig (Treasurer taking over for Larry Durrant), Mark Carroll and Molly Cox (taking over for Terri Holmes and Bill Pietsch). Terms for the new MMC members will begin in July.

Additionally, the congregation unanimously approved a motion to extend a call to one of three possible associate pastors. Each of these pastors will be newly graduated from the St. Louis seminary. If we are successful with the seminary matching one of these three candidates with our congregation in April, then we will formally issue a call.
