

A great big thank you to everyone who volunteered at FMSC on May 9. We had 20 volunteers who helped pack 86 boxes of food which resulted in 18,576 meals, which will feed 51 kids for a year. The cost for our session was \$5,387.04. More than 99% of meals shipped have reached their destination & of every dollar donated, more than 90 cents goes straight into producing meals.
