Over three incredible days, more than 2,800 guests joined the adventure. We hope you were among them—sharing laughs, finding bargains, & feeling warmly welcomed. We are the hands & feet of God when we are helping others, & we hope each person who came felt Jesus working through us.

We welcomed many new faces to our volunteers this year, with new friendships & shared laughter. Even members of the wider community joined in. THANK YOU to everyone who gave their time, space, & flexibility while the sale took over the building!

We are excited (& blessed) to share that this year, we raised \$38.000!!! WOW!!

A portion of the proceeds will go towards Immanuel upgrading building automation (HVAC, etc)—helping to care for the space that brings us all together.
